#### **Labelled Water bottles**

It is essential that all the walkers in Long and Medium Divisions bring their own water in a labelled (name and competition no.) transparent bottle and place it on the **drinks table** prior to the start of their race. This is the **ONLY place** walkers can collect water from during races of

**5km or longer** up to and including 10km. ONLY races further than 10km can have drinks other than water, if desired.
